**myEZfix CPR Non-Bootting Recovery Software Adds
Support for Windows® 2000 and Expands Data Off-loading Capabilities**

(NASHUA, NH, June 20, 2002) — myEZfix, a developer of self-service repair software for Microsoft® Windows-based systems, today announced **CPR for XP/2000 v2.0**, a tool that lets users quickly recover inoperable systems from severe configuration problems. CPR for XP/2000 adds support for Windows 2000 in addition to its existing compatibility with Windows XP. Additionally, CPR expands its data off-load feature to support the transfer of data from inoperable systems to USB memory key or CDR.

CPR Brings Non-Bootting Windows XP & Windows 2000 Systems Back to Life

"Windows 2000 accounts for a significant portion of the operating systems shipped on new PCs, and it is unquestionably the predominant operating system used in corporate America," states Jan Olsen, Vice President, Marketing & Sales for myEZfix. "Furthermore, these systems are often not equipped with built-in system tools that protect against faulty installations, Registry corruption, or damaging configuration changes that can be inadvertently made by users or maliciously introduced to the system by way of a virus. The release of CPR for XP/2000 provides Windows 2000 users with an effective, uncomplicated system tool that can rescue them from the worst stages of disrepair." When a system has encountered a serious problem that has rendered it non-bootting, CPR can typically restore the system to working order in less than 5 minutes, without data or application loss. Alternatively, without CPR for XP/2000 users are often forced to restore a lengthy backup archive, or to perform a time-consuming system reformat and reload of the operating system and applications, risking the loss of vital data. Another noteworthy aspect of CPR's innovative design is the fact that Windows XP users **do not need** to have previously installed CPR software in order to perform recovery, enabling them to perform "after the fact" restorations on inoperable PCs.

Data Off-loading for Unrecoverable PCs

If the inoperable system cannot be restored to Windows, users also have the ability to retrieve important data files through an easy to use **Data Off-loading** feature. This feature provides access to files and lets users copy them to another media for transfer to and access on another system. CPR for XP/2000 extends its Data Off-loading feature to support file replication to floppy disk, CDR, and USB memory key.

Broad System Protection with Enhanced Tracking and Protection

CPR for XP/2000 provides superior system protection through comprehensive tracking of a broad range of system components. It safeguards a series of system configuration files including the Registry, and CPR also tracks components involved in the system boot process. This enhanced tracking mechanism improves the chances of successful recovery when viruses or program/update installations make changes to important start-up components that disable a system's ability to boot. Additionally, CPR for XP/2000 automatically detects any new program

installation and creates a pre-installation checkpoint for use in restoration, in the event that the install program creates a conflict on the system.

Availability and Pricing

CPR for XP/2000 costs \$30 per license and it will be available on July 8, 2002. For users wishing to obtain CPR capabilities immediately, a version is available now that is fully functional with the exception of data off-loading support for CDR. A free upgrade from this version to version 2.0 can be obtained after July 8 by contacting myEZfix. Alternatively, advance orders are accepted and billing will be delayed until product is shipped.
